

2023 NRL FOOTY TIPPING COMPETITION TERMS & CONDITIONS

Below are the terms and conditions relating to the 2023 NRL Footy Tipping competition:

1. The competition covers all NRL games from R1 - Grand Final (excl. special games like City to Country & State of Origin)
2. Entry costs \$50 per person.

HOW TO PLAY

3. Tippers can only enter as an online **or** in Club tipper. Tippers cannot alternate methods of tipping.
4. Online tips will be submitted through ESPN tipping portal. Once payment is received, a code will be given to allow access into the Recky comp page.
5. For in Club tippers, tips should be placed prior to kick-off of the first game each round. The tipping box is located at the end of the sports bar. The tipping box will be removed at the kick-off of game 1 each round.
6. If tipping online, tips must be lodged prior to kick off of the relevant game. You can enter or change your tips at any time so long as the change is made **prior to kick off for that game.**

SCORING

7. Each Monday, all tips will be marked, and the leader board updated online and in the Sports Bar.
8. Scoring is as follows:
 - a. Two points are awarded for a win, zero points for a loss, and 1 point for a draw (where you have nominated a winning team).
 - b. Any player who scores a perfect round (**on a full round of games**) will receive an extra 2 points.
9. **Rounds 5, 15 and 25 will be known as Joker Rounds** and each participant's score in that round will be Doubled (a great way to make up lost ground on the leaders). **Please note if you score a perfect round on a double points round you still only receive 2 additional points after your score has been doubled.**
10. **If you do not enter your tips, you will automatically be awarded two points less than the lowest score for that round.** This may mean that you will receive no points if the lowest score for that round is two points.

PRIZES

11. Each week, one footy tipper will be chosen at random to receive the weekly prize of \$12 loaded onto their members card (or 2 schooner vouchers if a non member).
12. The winner will be the person or persons with the highest score at the end of the NRL 25 Round season.
13. Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd. Prize amounts will be determined by the number of entrants, however as a guide, last year's winner took home \$1400!
14. If more than 1 person has the same score for 1st, 2nd or 3rd, then the prize pool for that placing and the next one will be distributed evenly amongst the players with that score. For example, if 2 players are tied for 1st, then the pool for 1st and 2nd will be combined and divided evenly. Next highest scorer will win the 3rd prize pool.
15. An end of season party for Footy Tipping entrants will be held on the 1st weekend of the finals where the winners will be announced.
16. The moderator's decision is final.
